**BOARD OF TRUSTEES' PRIORITY # 1**

**All students should pass all state mandated tests.** Toward accomplishment of this priority during the 2005-2006 school year the Board wishes to see:

- Continued improvement at all levels on all TAKS tests resulting in attainment of district "Exemplary" accreditation status
- A narrowing of the difference in percentage of mastery of the TAKS test between all students and African American, economically disadvantaged, and Special Education subgroups
- Provide the necessary time, effort, and materials to insure all seniors pass the EXIT Level of TAKS
- Campuses will continue to recognize students who meet attendance goals and aggressively pursue students who fail to comply with attendance guidelines
- Align and strengthen the curriculum to insure KCISD becomes a National Leader in Educational Excellence

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES' PRIORITY # 2**

**Recognize outstanding employee and student accomplishments.** Toward accomplishment of this priority during the 2005-2006 school year the Board wishes to:

- Continue the recognition at regular board meetings of employees and students with special accomplishments as well as community members' contributions to the school district
- Develop an incentive program whereby staff members are recognized for their students' academic progress as measured by the District administered Curriculum Benchmark Assessments (CBA)
- Develop and implement a citizenship program that encourages each student to engage in meaningful service to the community.
- Attract, retain and develop a diverse, highly qualified, innovative and visionary staff.

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES' PRIORITY # 3**

**Provide for utilization, renovation, enhancement, and construction of district facilities while planning for future needs.** Toward accomplishment of this priority during the 2005-2006 year the Board wishes to:

- Begin development of long-range facility development plan for the District.
- Practice fiscal responsibility of revenue to insure funds are available to fulfill future long range plans.
